

Children's Board of Hillsborough County Case Management Training Series

This training will introduce Hillsborough County case managers and supervisors to the skills and best practices recommended for case management services provided to the citizens of Hillsborough County (Courses 1 and 2), and also provide information on the Medicaid reimbursement requirements for Targeted Case Management (TCM) for Children At Risk of Abuse and Neglect services (Course 3) and TCM-at risk Field Training (Course 4).

To become credentialed in Case Management, you must complete Courses 1 and 2. To become credentialed in Targeted Case Management (TCM) you must complete all four courses listed below and be employed by a Medicaid enrolled agency for at risk targeted case management.

Course 1: Family Engagement (Netsmart E-Learning Course)

This is a two-hour, web-based course and is a prerequisite for Course 2: Family Team Conferencing.

Course 2: Family Team Conferencing (Live Classroom Course)

Course 3: Targeted Case Management (TCM) for Children At Risk of Abuse and Neglect (Netsmart E-Learning Course)

This is a 30-minute, web-based course.

Course 4: Targeted Case Management (TCM) for Children At Risk of Abuse and Neglect Field training

This training is scheduled, provided and documented by the organization's certified TCM at risk supervisor.
