Question 1:

How many letters of support are allowed?

Question 2:

There is no 6b in the appendix. Page 12 in instruction says the document does not need to be submitted with proposal, but appendix 6a says it does. What should be done?

Answer 3:

Please confirm that the entire funding opportunity is 1mil and will fund only one proposal?

Answer 4:

The amount per proposal is from \$600,000 up to \$1,000,000 with the total grant allocation of \$1,000,000. The number of proposals potentially funded can not be known at this time.
